The best way to develop leadership skills is to practice, practice, and practice. For four days each June, that is exactly what Missouri's brightest high school freshmen and sophomore student leaders do in the LEADERSHIP IN PRACTICE program developed by the Missouri Chamber Foundation. LEADERSHIP IN PRACTICE was developed over 21 years ago to develop and instill critical leadership, entrepreneurship and life skills to students throughout Missouri. Rotating across the state, this year's program will be held on the campus of Westminster College in Fulton, MO.

LEADERSHIP IN PRACTICE training is divided into four focus areas: global leadership, civic leadership, economic leadership and personal leadership. The key to the training is that students learn by participating in activities, simulations and small group discussions. They are mentored by experienced business, civic and education leaders from across the state, imparting real world knowledge to help guide the students during the forum. Students evaluate their leadership skills based on what they learn and then set goals on how to improve those skills. The end goal is that students emerge from the program better prepared to engage in leadership activities back in their respective high schools and communities.

Registration requirements:

- Student must currently be enrolled in the 9th or 10th grade and representing the Class of 2020 or 2021
- Student must be nominated by superintendent, principal, counselor, teacher, coach, business or civic leader, and a letter of recommendation must be provided
- Student must exhibit character, scholarship and leadership in the school and community, or have the potential to be a leader

Student Fee:

\$250 covers all direct costs related to the leadership forum including the application fee, housing, meals and materials

Application timeline:

- The application period opens on January 1, 2018
- The application deadline is April 1, 2018
- Acceptance notifications will be made on April 15, 2018
- Attendance must be confirmed by May 1, 2018

Housing:

 Attendees will be housed in dormitories located at Westminster College in Fulton, Missouri

Meals:

- Meals will be served beginning with the evening meal on Sunday through lunch on Wednesday
- A concession area will be available to purchase snacks

Supervision:

- Adult counselors will be provided for both the boys' and girls' dormitories
- Education, civic and business leaders mentor students during sessions
- Campus rules will be sent to parents and explained to students upon arrival
