Summer Opportunities for Advancement & Recovery

Dates: June 3rd-July 1st

Time: 7:30am-11:00am or 11:30am-3:00pm

(students may work at any time of the day that works for them, but teachers will be available during the above times)

WHS will hold a virtual summer school this year!

Certified teachers will be assigned to students to assist through coursework and troubleshoot technology questions. Once Summer School begins, students will be able to sign up for tutoring where they come into the West Wing and meet with their teacher for assistance. On or before the first day of Summer School, students will receive an email from their teacher as well as from the online platform on how to log in and begin their course work. Communication with students will occur via email and phone, if parental permission is granted. Students will be expected to stay on pace with course completion (ie 25% should be completed by June 11th, 50% should be completed by June 18th, 75% should be completed by June 25th, 100% of the course should be completed by July 1st). Students who are not keeping pace with course requirements may be required to attend tutoring sessions (in person or via zoom).

Enrollment for SDOW students will be from April 1st-May 28th .

On May 17th, depending on available spots, enrollment may open up to students outside of the SDOW.

Students may take classes for credit recovery or credit advancement.
A maximum of 2 courses can be taken, each worth 0.5 credit.
