Frequently Asked Questions

Where will the time capsule be stored? We have set aside lockers that will be painted and decorated in honor of the Class of 2021. Items will be preserved to our best ability and locked securely to be opened at a future date.

How do I purchase a spot in the time capsule? You may turn in cash with your item OR purchase online through SDOW WHS website.

When do we plan on opening the time capsule? We plan on revealing our items in the time capsule in 2041 at the Class of 2021 20th year reunion. The specific date is unknown.

Where do I turn in my item? Turn in your items to Room 1324 to Mrs. Perriman with the bottom slip filled out with correct information. We will only take your item after it's been purchased.

When can I turn in my items? You may turn in your items between April 26th to May 25th, the last day for seniors.

What are ideas for small items? recipes, letter to self, letters you've received, jewelry, artwork, DVD/CD, SD card, certificates/awards, newspaper clippings

What are ideas for medium items? badges, diary, golf ball/tee, baseball, bible, toy, fad item, magazine/newspaper

What are ideas for clothing items? jersey, club shirt, fashion piece, hat, shoes

Small items must be turned in in a manila envelope. Manila envelope cannot be bulky or it will be considered a medium item.
